Sustainability Criteria Comparison As of 1 October 2024

The sustainability criteria of Schoellerbank AG are being revised as of 1 October 2024. The following table compares the sustainability criteria that apply until 30 September 2024 with the new sustainability criteria (which apply from 1 October 2024).

Please note that the changes from October 1, 2024 are marked in RED in the table. The sustainability criteria apply to stocks and corporate bonds as well as government bonds, regardless of whether the stocks or bonds are held directly (in the form of individual securities) or indirectly (e.g. in the form of investment funds).

The following changes as of October 1, 2024 are marked in red in the table:

- New exclusion criterion: Companies that are assigned to certain controversial mining sectors and do not comply with international norms or standards
- Change: Production or distribution of weapons and military-specific armaments New: More than 10% of sales when invested in investment funds/ETFs of all other investment companies.

Please note that as of October 1, 2024, simple wording changes without any substantive impact were implemented in the sustainability criteria for better understanding.
